2019 CHRISTMAS PARADE RULES

1. Admittance to the Christmas Parade will be denied if an application has not been received by the Town of Terry by the deadline date.
2. Line-up for the parade will start one hour (5:30 p.m.) prior to the start of the Parade.
3. Anyone behaving inappropriately will be removed immediately.
4. All dogs must be "dressed" and on a leash. (No Pit Bulls, please.)
5. Christmas Parade Committee Members reserve the right to ask any horseback rider whose horse is not under control to exit the parade.
6. Fire engine sirens or horn blowing will only be allowed at the direction of the official parade announcer. (Flyers will be handed to each driver at the time of line-up.)
7. No other horns or sirens will be allowed by other fire or police vehicles.
8. Christmas Parade Committee Members reserve the right to disqualify any applicant before or at the time of the parade due to noncompliance of these rules.
9. No entry, other than marching bands directed by the announcer, will be allowed to stop on the parade route and perform unless pre-arranged with the parade coordinator. When a parade entry stops in front of your entry, you must stop...and when they start moving again, you must start moving immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS!

You must maintain a 30 foot distance between you and the entry in front of you at all times.

10. No one driving a vehicle under 18 years old.
11. The Fire Department will provide the only Santa for the parade.
12. As a participant in the Town Of Terry Christmas Parade, the Town Of Terry and/or the Parade Committee Members are not liable in case of accident or injury to the party during the parade line-up or duration of the parade.
